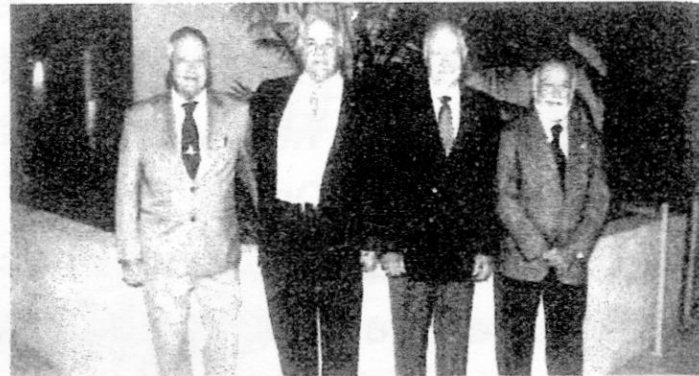

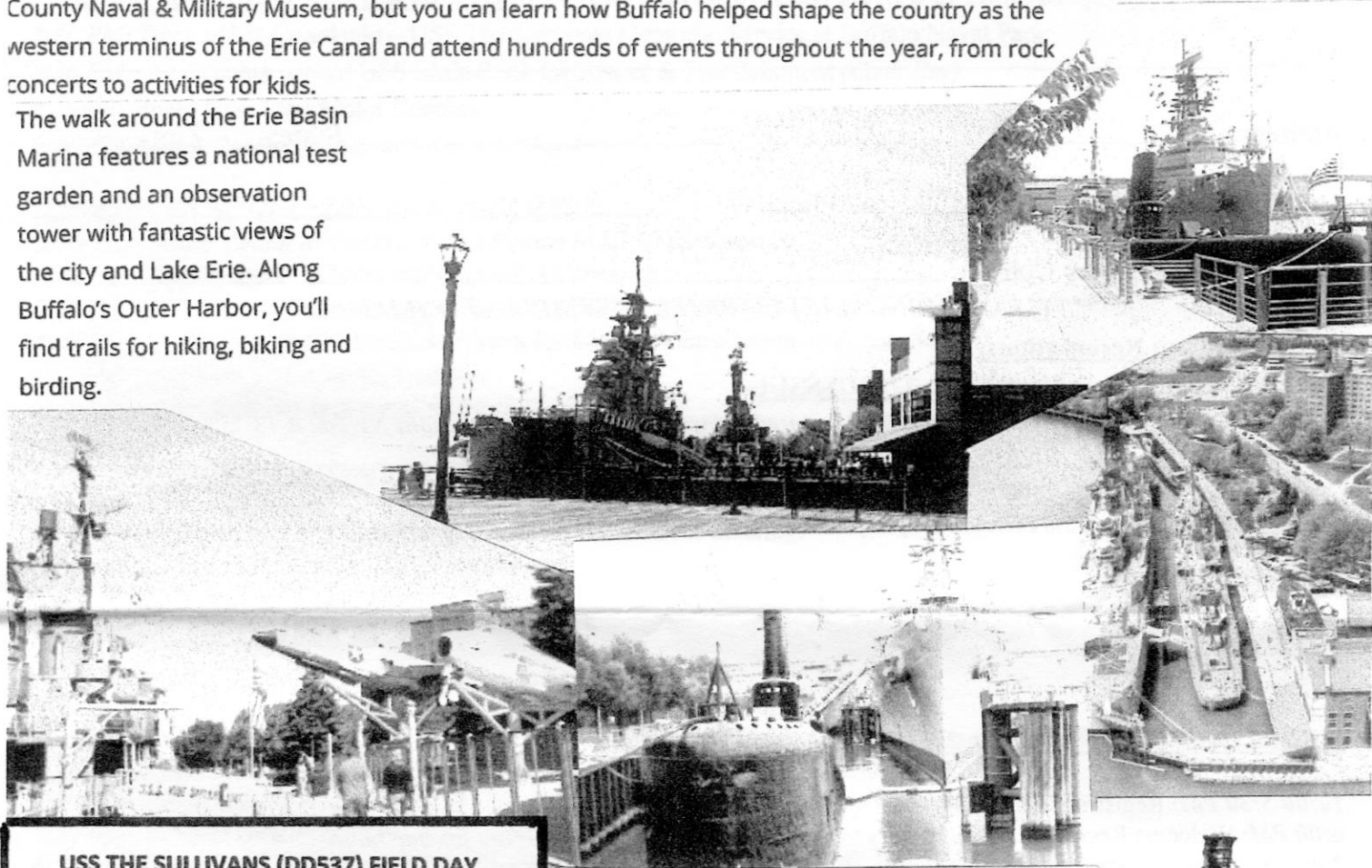
HAPPY ST. PATRICK'S DAY

At Buffalo's historic Erie Canal Harbor, not only can you tour WWII warships at the Buffalo & Erie County Naval & Military Museum, but you can learn how Buffalo helped shape the country as the western terminus of the Erie Canal and attend hundreds of events throughout the year, from rock concerts to activities for kids.

The walk around the Erie Basin Marina features a national test garden and an observation tower with fantastic views of the city and Lake Erie. Along Buffalo's Outer Harbor, you'll find trails for hiking, biking and birding.
